As a minimum, **energy use** from electricity, gas and transport fuel – as well as the **associated GHG emissions** – **must be reported**.

## ARE YOU REQUIRED TO REPORT?

The new regulations will require up to 12,000 companies in the UK to disclose their energy and carbon emissions.

A company must report if they meet at least two of the following three criteria in a reporting year:

- Turnover > £36million
- Balance sheet > £18million
- **Employees** > 250
